- Creation of a Future Ready email address allowing parents a way to get CCMR questions answered by members of our team.



Complete Texas College Bridge for Math and/or English or Enroll in college Prep Math and/or English.



# **Complete OnRamps**

Complete an OnRamps Course and earn college credit.

# Advanced Placement/ Dual Credit

Score or Higher on an AP Exam or Complete 3 hours of Dual Credit in Math and English or 9 hours in any other content.

# **Enlist in Military**

Enlist in any branch of the Military and provide your Enlistment documentation (Form DD4) to your school.

# **College Readiness Assessment**

Students take one of the following assessments and score above threshold:

TSI: Eng: 945, Essay: 5, Math: 950


SAT: Eng: 480, Math: 530


ACT: Composite: 23, Math & English: 19

Students complete 3 or more CTE Courses in a Program of Study and earn an Industry Based Certification.

Update your individual graduation plan (IGP) to ensure graduation requirements are met and focus on AP exams, Dual Credit Courses, and any remaining certificates

### GOAL

Maintain strong academic standing through graduation

# **ACTION**

Participate in internships, job shadowing, or leadership activities to strengthen career readiness

### GOAL

Build a resume that reflects skills and experience for postsecondary success

# **ACTION**

Meet with counselor regularly to discuss progress, address challenges, and confirm graduation and postsecondary requirements

### **GOAL**

Ensure a smooth transition to life after high school

# **ACTION**

Attend events like decision days, graduation prep sessions, and college orientation programs

Finalize and celebrate your readiness for the future
